Critical gaps in compliance. Immediate remediation required. Priority attention needed before accreditation submission.

Five-Step Audit Process

- Mapping & Alignment – Map curriculum and governance structures to MQA/MMC accreditation standards and identify compliance gaps.
- Governance Validation – Verify institutional approvals, programme permits, and regulatory documentation are current and complete.
- Evidence Collection & Internal Review – Gather supporting documentation, conduct self-assessment, and implement continuous improvement cycles.
